This is an award winning renovation of the Main Library replacing all HVAC systems, replacing the roof system, and replacing or upgrading electrical, acoustic, and lighting components. In addition most public restrooms in the facility were completely renovated. Working closely with Engineer John Phelps, the design contains spaces for patrons that increase light levels three times the previous level. Acoustic tiles were installed to eliminate previous acoustic reverberation problems and provide a welcoming reading space. Main Library was able to recover all funds spent on this project in saved energy cost.
