This is the first civic structure of the Norton Commons® Planned Village in Louisville, Kentucky. The building serves the community as a public recreational facility. The challenge of the project was to satisfy the modern requirements of a public pool facility and yet respond to the traditional design standards of Norton Commons® by looking back to the historic buildings of Louisville. In this case, much of the design was influenced both by the Churchill Down's club house and Fountain Ferry amusement park. This new building harkens back to a more simple, leisurely life.
